





# Meet Your All-American Judges


2025 ABS All-American Show San Diego, California

#### **RAFFLE**

Sunday morning there will be a large raffle of many Budgie related items, including many bags of seed, breeding cages, and a host of other useful items! Raffle tickets will be available at registration and throughout the show with cut-off being announced shortly before the draws.

#### **AA 2025 SHOW RULES**

#### GENERAL SHOW RULES:

- 1. All exhibitors will follow the "Official ABS Rules for Affiliated Societies" as found on the ABS website: abs1.org and ABS Classifications and Rules will apply and there will be Champion, Intermediate, Novice, Junior and Rare Divisions.
- 2. Entry fee will be \$7 per bird, and all entries over 15 are free (maximum of \$105). Exhibitors are encouraged to pre-order show tags by texting Leon Saad (619-246-8529) and providing name and address for mailing and how many show tags needed and for which divisions. Separate entry sheets must be completed for Rare entries. Standard clips or rings will be provided at check in.
- 3. All Birds must be entered and in the Show Hall on Friday September 19 between the hours of 2:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. Limited bird entry on Saturday morning September 20 will be allowed between 8 8:15 a.m. only by prior arrangement with Show Manager, and must be "stage ready" in show cage with paperwork. Once entered the birds are entered they will be under the control of Show management, and may not be removed until the designated time and after being signed out by a Show Official.
- 4. As per ABS rules, double banded birds are allowed, as long as the bands are closed bands traceable to the same exhibitor who bred and banded the bird. Only ABS banded birds are eligible for ABS awards. Separate BFSDC awards will be available without such restriction.
- 5. All birds must be entered in standard show cages, one per cage, with seed on the bottom. Exhibitors are encouraged to bring their own seed for this purpose (best that their birds have their usual diet). A limited amount of seed will be available at the Show Hall as needed.
- 6. Exhibitors must classify their own birds. However certified ABS classifiers will be available as needed and will have final say on questionable classification, subject only to the Judge's right to reclassify birds.
- 7. Judging will begin at 9:00 a.m. on Saturday September 20, 2025. Exhibitors and guests will extend every courtesy to the Judges and Show officials in the course of their duties. All decisions by Judges and Show Mangers shall be final and binding. Please set all communication devices to silent mode during judging and speeches.
- 8. Bird viewing is encouraged and there are scheduled times for this after completion of judging and announcement of results, and on Sunday morning September 21, 2025.
- 9. The best possible care will be provided while the birds are in the show hall, and they will be secured in the show hall after hours. However, BFSDC, its members and Show Officials, and ABS will not be responsible for any loss or damage to exhibitors' birds or property, before, after or during the show.
- 10. CHECK OUT shall occur 10:00 a.m. 11:00 a.m. on Sunday morning September 21, 2025. Exception will only be granted by prior approval from the Show Manager, for emergencies & good cause. All birds must be signed out by a Show Official before removal.
- 11. By virtue of entering their birds in this AA 2025 Show, all exhibitors accept these Rules and agree to be bound by them.

#### RARE DIVISION RULES:

- 1. All Rare birds must be entered on separate entry sheets and shown in the Rare Division.
- 2. The Show secretaries will keep records of Rare birds by Junior, Novice, Intermediate and Champion Division.
- 3. All birds entered in the Rare Division are also governed by the General Show Rules SALES BIRDS:
  - All birds sold during or in connection with AA2025 shall be subject to a fee of 5% of the sales price payable to BFSDC. Designated table space to display sales birds will be available at an additional charge of \$50 per 3ft of linear space.
